

## NC State Parks Celebrates its 100th Birthday by Partnering with the NC Science Festival

In celebration of turning 100, NC State Park superintendents, rangers and staff explored the theme of Science in the Great Outdoors during 50 special NC Science Festival events across the state. More than 4,700 visitors participated in hands-on fun through programs like S'more Science, the Reptile & Amphibian BioBlitz and the Statewide Star Party.





## The Festival strives to serve the 10 million people of our great state.

This year, we had events in 99 of NC's 100 counties, a new record. The lineup featured fantastic events designed to attract new audiences. Thirty-seven percent of our audiences attended events held in Tier 1 counties\*. Eighty-one percent of public attendees were able to attend events that were free of charge.

\*The 40 most distressed counties are designated as Tier 1. Tiers are calculated using average unemployment rate, median household income, percentage growth in population and property tax base per capita.
